



Poster Presentation Preparation Guidelines

1. Posters must be prepared in **vertical (portrait)** format with dimensions of **70 cm x 100 cm**, and the language of preparation must be **English**.
2. The title must be written **in bold**, with a font size of at least **48 points**, and should not exceed two lines.
3. Author names must be written in **bold Arial font**, size **36 points**. The advisor's name must be included among the authors.
4. Author information must be in 36-point font size; each author's full name, along with their university, faculty/institute, and department, must be clearly stated.
5. Section headings (e.g., "Introduction," "Method") should be in **bold font**, sized between **36 and 42 points**.
6. The main text should be between **24 and 28 points** in size, justified on both sides, and formatted with **1.5 line spacing**.
7. **Times New Roman font** should be used for the main text.
8. Visual materials (images, tables, graphs, etc.) may be included in the posters.
9. Visuals should be designed to be easily readable from a distance of **approximately 2 meters**.
10. In-text citations, references, table and figure formatting must conform to **APA6 style** guidelines.
11. Text within figures and tables should be easily readable, and a consistent font style should be used throughout all visuals.
12. Poster presenters must be present at their posters during the time specified in the program to provide information about their work.
